With **87% of our consumers on Medicaid**, these unprecedented budget cuts threaten their access to basic necessities like housing, food, and medicine.

Imagine having to choose between a meal and vital medication. For many of our consumers, this is their reality. The cuts also mean fewer transportation services for medical appointments and less access to technology that helps combat isolation and loneliness. These are not just services; they are lifelines.

The urgency of this situation cannot be overstated. Our upcoming fall fundraiser at the Westin Copley Place is a crucial event to support the 10,000 older adults we serve throughout Boston neighborhoods.
